



Early marriage occurs in practically every region of the world. Every 3 seconds somewhere a girl under 18 is married. The problem's dimension in Europe is comparatively lower but there are still regions and communities where it persists. UNICEF, UNFRA (2012) and ERRC (2011) studies reveal this problem as featuring in Central and Eastern Europe, especially within the Roma communities there.

Wherever it occurs, an early marriage is a harmful practice, related to the violation of a child's basic rights to health, education and security.

This final conference of the Early Marriage Prevention Network project, aims to:

- Generate debate on good strategies in preventing early marriages;
- Discuss possible challenges and solutions concerning early marriages in Roma communities;
- Present the EMPN project and its activities.
